Tenderers are required to submit proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor issued by SANAS or a SWORN AFFIDAVIT in terms of codes of good practice". Failure to submit B-BBEE status level of contributor will result on bid being non-responsive or disqualified.

Only tenderers who compliance with their Tax obligations, tenderers are required to submit their unique personal identification number (pin) issued by SARS to enable the organ of state to view the taxpayer's profile and tax status. In bids where consortia / joint ventures / sub-contractors are involved, each party must submit a separate proof of TCS / PIN / CSD number. Where no TCS is available but the bidder is registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD), a CSD number must be provided. Attendance of the compulsory tender clarification meeting as stipulated and a letter of authorization to sign the form of offer and where required in tender document as well as the bank rating of A or B or C are eligible to submit tenders.
