Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late Tenders will not be accepted.

Tender Eligibility Criteria:

Only Tenderers who comply with the following criteria are eligible to submit tenders:

1. Bidders must be registered with the CIDB, and it is estimated that Bidders should have a grading designation of **7CE** or higher;
2. Only those tenderers who have in their employ management and supervisory staff satisfying the requirements of the scope of work and who have completed the relevant NQF Level 4 and/ or 5 Unit Standards in labour-intensive competencies. Refer to Tender Data Clause 3.8.3. Attach certified proof.
3. Construction Manager (full time on site), suitably skilled and have a CV with verifiable experience as foreman on Civil Engineering services for housing related projects, including sewer, water, roads and stormwater reticulation infrastructure with a minimum of 10 years' experience;
4. The Bidder must provide information on a similar project with a minimum Contract value of R20m and have successfully completed Civil Engineering services for housing related projects, including sewer, water, roads and stormwater reticulation infrastructure, for projects that have been completed in the past seven (7) years, accompanied by a reference letter from a contactable reference related to that experience;
5. The Bidder must provide a complete list (as specified in the tender documents) of plant/ tools/ equipment which will be available specifically for this Contract. The tenderer shall differentiate, if applicable, between plant / tools / equipment immediately available plant / tools / equipment will be acquired or hired for the work should he be awarded the tender. If no information is provided or referred to as an additional attachment, the tender will be considered as non-responsive.
6. A non-refundable deposit of **R550-00** per document must be paid at the Supply Chain Management Unit, First Floor, Civic Centre, York Street, George.
