Tenders are hereby invited for the:

APPOINTMENT OF A BUILDING CONTRACTOR TO CONSTRUCT 100 SUBSIDISED HOUSES IN THEMBALETHU

Tenders may only be submitted on the Tender documentation that is issued.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of Tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

Tenders will be opened on the same day in the Committee Room at 12:05. Late or unmarked Tenders will not be considered. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late Tenders will not be accepted.

Tender documents will be made available from the date of advertisement at the offices of Zutari (Pty) Ltd. Tenderers are required to arrange for tender documents at least 2 days in advance and can be arranged with Zutari (Pty) Ltd, Joubert Theart at 044 805-5400 or george@zutari.com. Tender documents can be made available at the clarification meeting only by prior arrangement.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will be held at the Conference Hall, Civic Centre, 71 York Street, George at **11:00** on **26 JULY 2024**.

Tender Eligibility Criteria:

Only Tenderers who comply with the following criteria are eligible to submit tenders:

1. Bidders must be registered with the CIDB, and it is estimated that Bidders should have a grading designation of **6 GB** or higher;
2. Bidders must be registered with the NHBRC.
3. Construction Manager (full time on site), suitably skilled and have a CV with verifiable experience as foreman on building projects with a minimum of 10 years' experience;
4. The Bidder must provide information on a similar project (BNG houses) with a minimum of 50 units or more, per project, which he has completed in the past seven (7) years, accompanied by a reference letter from a contactable reference related to that experience;
5. The tendered amount must be more or less in line with the 2023 subsidy quantum amount for houses to be financed from The National Housing Programme (40m² and 45m² houses); and
6. A non-refundable deposit of R550-00 per document must be paid at the Supply Chain Management Unit, First Floor, Civic Centre, York Street, George.
